Jan-Michael STEILS started his professional life 2004 as a farmer and worked in agricultural research until 2010. He then studied veterinary medicine in Leipzig and, from 2016, dealt intensively with questions of milk production, milk quality and milk analysis both in research and in industry. Finding suitable practical solutions for old and new challenges is a particular motivation for Steils.

Since 2020 he is a German representative on the Standing Committee on Residues and Chemical Contaminants in the International Dairy Federation (SC RCC, IDF). As an entrepreneur, Steils began founding Tec2-Fit GmbH in 2018, where he and his partner develop and market solutions for innovative lameness therapies. In 2021, pureMilk analytical GmbH was founded, which deals with solutions for simplifying milk fractionation. This optimizes sample preparation for milk residue analysis, both analytically and economically.

At the beginning of 2023 he dedicated himself to a new veterinary task.
